Open:

1. What do you expect or hope to inherit from your parents or grandparents?
2. What do you hope to pass on one day to your children or relatives?

Dig:

Read: Romans 8:1-4

3. How would you explain the gospel to one who senses he or she is not “good enough” for God?
4. How is “no condemnation” related to the idea of justification (3:24, 5:1)?

Read: Romans 8:5-11

5. What does Paul say about living according to the sinful nature and living according to the Spirit? What are the implications of each?

Read: Romans 8:12-17

6. Since we are not set right with God by doing good works, what is the motive for changing our lives? How are we to deal with our sinful nature (Vs 13-14)

7. How does the story of Easter give us hope and courage to live into the life God calls us to life?
8. How does knowing that you are God’s child not his slave impact our way of life?
